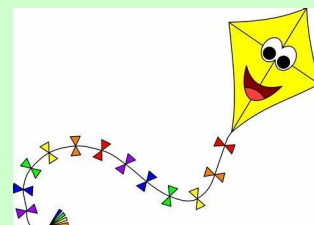

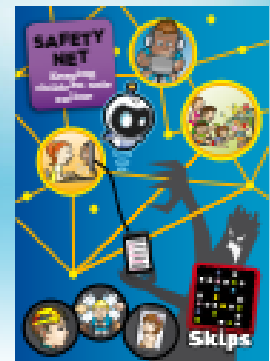

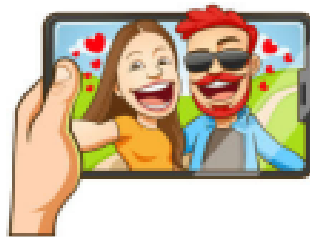
School's out for summer!
