This week's Spotlight...



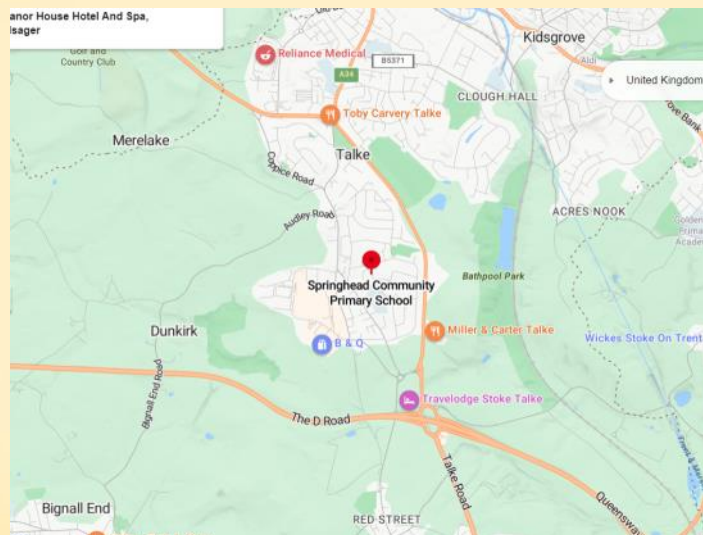
We are family!!
