Picture news

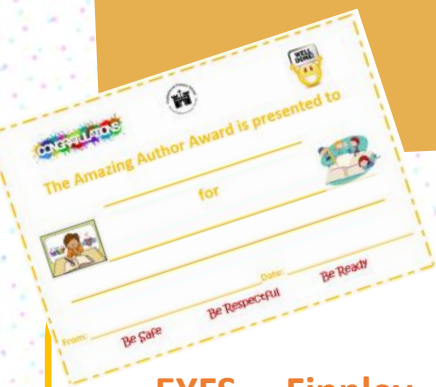

Uniform-Polite reminder

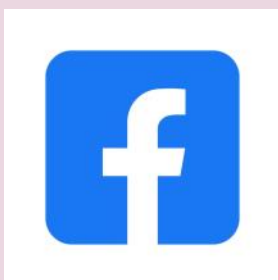

May we remind you that we expect the children to wear full Castlechurch uniform so that we remain smart at all times.
